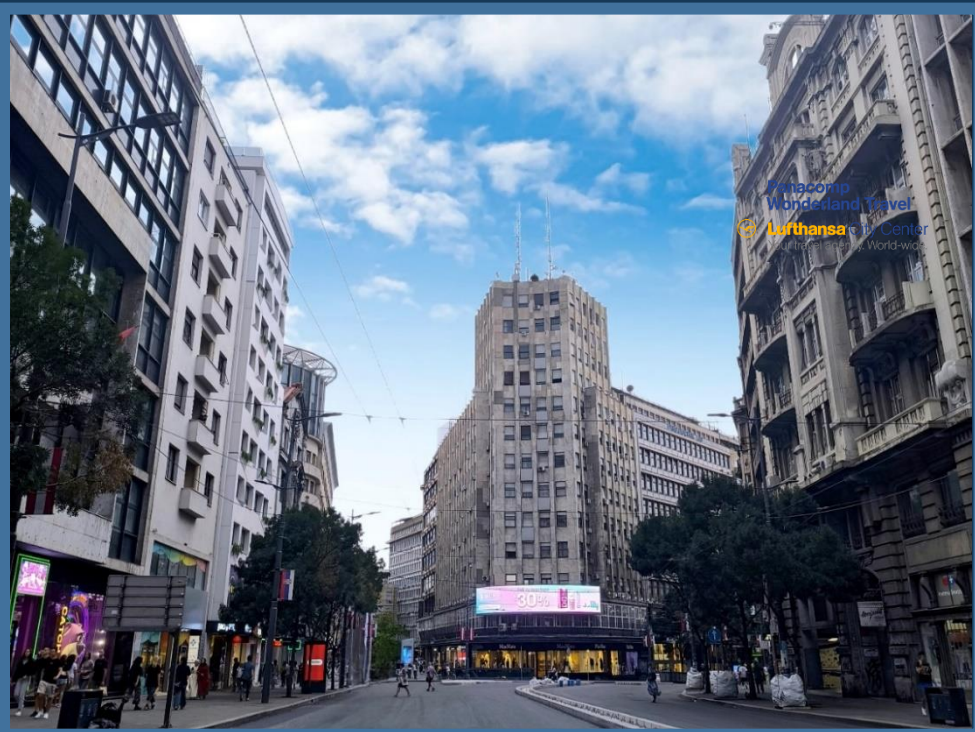
33rd Summer School and International Symposium on Physics of Ionized Gases

August 25–28, 2026, Belgrade, Serbia

Welcome

Dear colleagues, it is our pleasure to invite you to participate in the 33rd Summer School and International Symposium on the Physics of Ionized Gases - **SPIG 2026**. The conference will be held at the Serbian Academy of Sciences and Arts in Belgrade, Serbia, from **August 25 to 28, 2026**. The program will start on the morning of August 25, featuring associated workshops and a welcome cocktail. It will conclude on August 28, with a full-day program followed by a conference dinner.

Additionally, the 33rd SPIG encompasses two workshops that are closely related to the conference topics: 3rd Workshop on Swarm Physics and Gaseous Dielectrics (SPGD) and 5th Workshop on X-ray and VUV Interaction with Biomolecules in Gas Phase (XiBiGP). Dress code

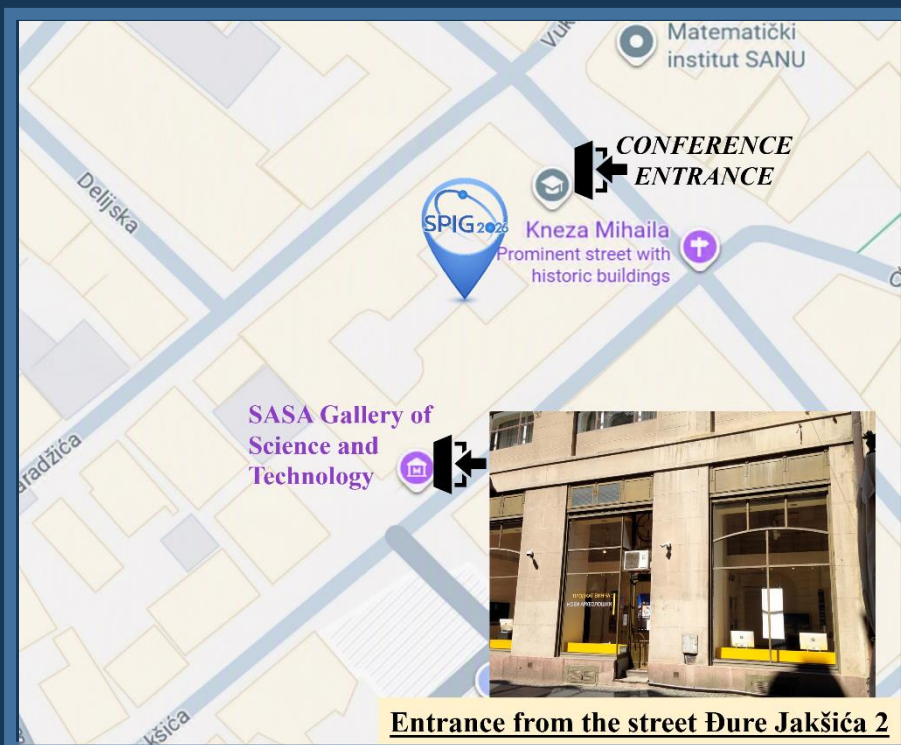
Serbian Academy of Sciences and Arts is a distinguished institution of supreme national importance. We kindly ask you to respect the dress code and not to wear:

Transport Information

From Airport

Transport options:

- Bus 72** → Zeleni Venac (free of charge)
- A1 Minibus** → Slavija Square (Kralja Milutina Street), ticket can be bought from the driver. Payment is only in cash (RSD)
- Taxi** (20–30 min), with *a fixed-price voucher* (Zone 2) 3500 RSD (~ 30 EUR)
- Organized airport transfer**, 40 EUR per car, per direction

Passengers using taxi services from Belgrade Nikola Tesla Airport have **a fixed-price option** available depending on the city zone they are traveling in. *Four e-kiosks are available to issue a fixed-price voucher.*

Taxi Fixed-Price E-Kiosks

Purpose: Print official fixed-zone price vouchers for airport taxis to avoid overcharging.

Locations: Three units in the baggage claim area and one unit in the passenger arrivals/welcome lounge.

Usage: Select your destination zone on the screen, take the printed paper voucher, and hand it to the driver at the official taxi rank in front of the Arrivals Terminal.

Please note that the conference venue and hotels listed on the conference website are in Zone 2 (city center - Stari Grad Municipality).

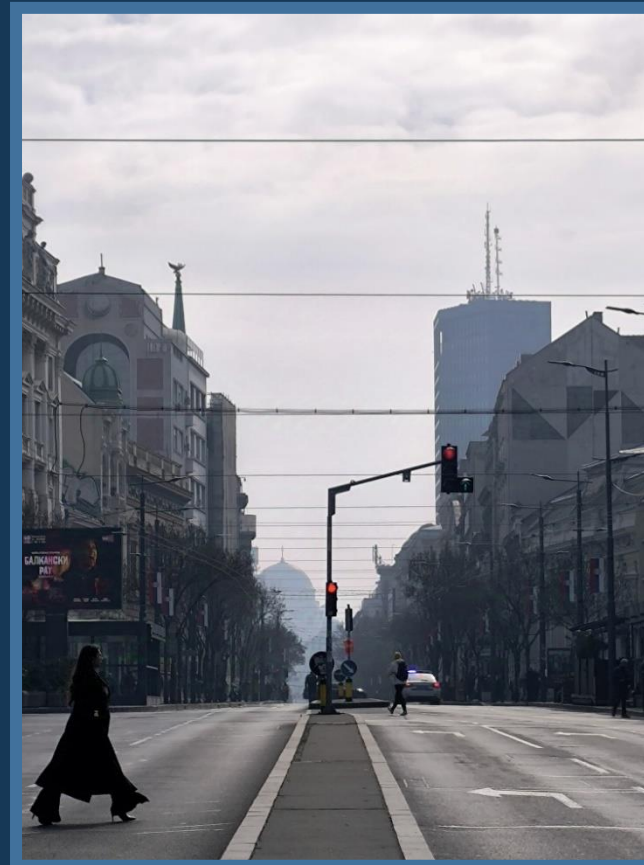

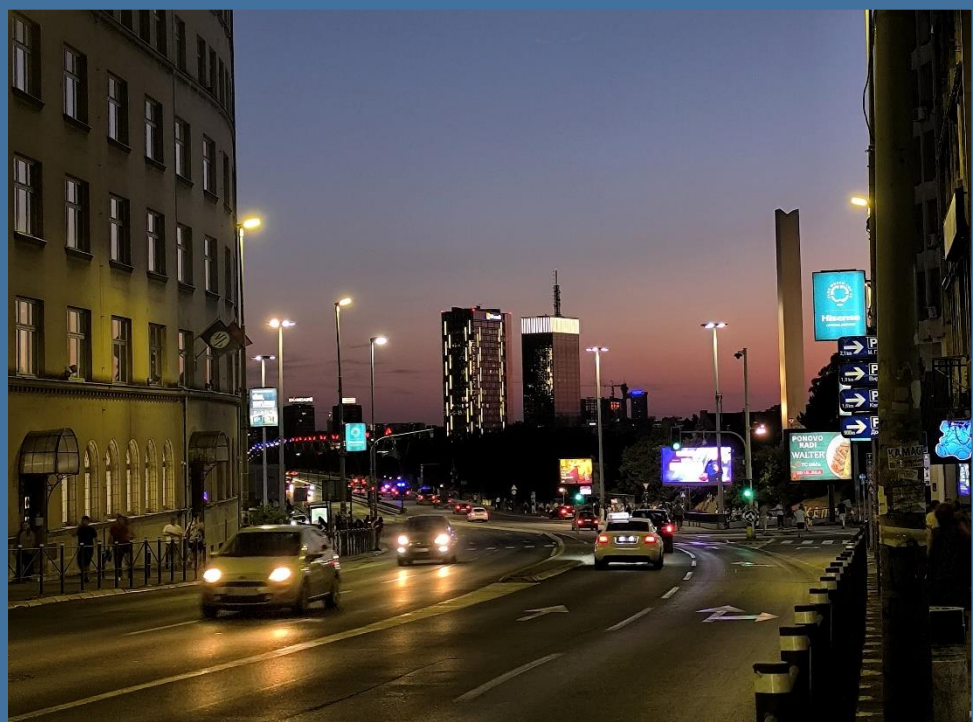
